PURPOSE

The Modern Worship Leader will provide consistent musical and spiritual leadership of our modern and youth worship services. Working together with the worship and youth department staff members, this person will be responsible for the development and implementation of a vision for music ministry and disciple-making in these two corporate worship contexts at Chapel Hill. The primary measures of the success of this person will not only be the engagement levels of these congregations, but also this person's ability to identify, equip, and launch musicians and other volunteers.

PRIMARY DUTIES

- Collaborate with the worship and youth department staff members to plan and lead services, including the selection, preparation, and leadership of music appropriate to each context.
- Maintain regular contact with all musicians and volunteers, advising them of pertinent information regarding services, music, rehearsals, etc.
- Create opportunities for new musicians and volunteers to be a part of modern music ministry at Chapel Hill through auditions or other recruiting techniques.
- Maintain regular contact with worship director and worship planning team to participate in vision development and implementation in line with the goals and strategies of the church.

KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS

- Personal faith in Jesus Christ and a theology consistent with the mission of Chapel Hill Presbyterian Church
- Ability to lead worship within a band context and ability for solo instrumental and vocal worship leadership
- Ability to lead and disciple both youth and adult musicians and other volunteers
- Well-rounded knowledge of a variety of musical styles both inside and outside the context of worship music
- Highly creative problem-solving skills
- Ability to work with individuals representing a wide spectrum of musical ability and/or spiritual maturity
- Ability to handle multiple projects, often times with tight deadlines in organized and timely manner

EDUCATION/TRAINING

- Musical training that allows for writing, arranging, and transposing chord charts and lead sheets
 - Experience leading worship in a church context (4+ years preferred)
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
