Student Ministries Summer Intern

Purpose

Provide a learning opportunity in Chapel Hill's Student Ministry departments for post-high school students connected to the ministries of Chapel Hill. The intern will assist with aspects of the middle school ministry (grades 6-8) and high school ministry (grades 9-12).

Primary Duties

- 1. Build relationships with students in order to present the gospel of Jesus Christ to them and encourage their growth through the study of scripture, prayer, fellowship and service.
- 2. Assist the Student Ministries staff in the planning and executing of ministry programs, including keeping students and parents informed regarding upcoming events.
- 3. Provide administrative support to the department, including publications, mailings, calendars, phone calls, etc.
- 4. Work amicably in conjunction with other Student Ministries staff and the greater church staff by performing other duties as assigned.

Knowledge and Experience

- 1. Growing personal commitment to Jesus Christ, the body of Christ and God's work in the world.
- 2. Ability to work effectively with youth, exhibiting creativity, understanding and patience.
- 3. Excellent communication skills (verbal and written)
- 4. Flexibility in a multi-task, fast-paced, changing environment.

Internship Details

- 1. Benefits to intern:
 - a. Gain practical ministry training and church experience
 - b. Work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support
 - c. Test their gifts and call to vocational ministry
 - d. Develop spiritually and theologically
- 2. Education: this internship is designed for post-high school applicants (high school graduates and current college students) who have an interest or passion in ministry.
- 3. Duration of internship: 8 weeks / June 23 August 15, 2014
- 4. Compensation: \$2,000 (as a scholarship paid directly to the intern's school in the fall of 2014 or paid as wages which would be subject to taxes).
- 5. Schedule: Approximately 20-25 hours per week Wednesday evenings, Sundays and other days as scheduled.
- 6. Benefits: none
