Student Ministries Intern (High School)

Purpose

Provide a learning opportunity for the intern in Chapel Hill's Student Ministries department. The intern will be primarily involved with the high school ministry (grades 9-12) and will have a strong presence in the middle school ministry (grades 6-8).

Primary Duties

- 1. Build relationships with students in order to present the gospel of Jesus Christ to them and encourage their growth through the study of scripture, prayer, fellowship and service.
- 2. Assist the Student Ministries staff in the planning and executing of ministry programs, including keeping students and parents informed regarding upcoming events.
- 3. Assist in the coordination and development of volunteers (students and adults).
- 4. Provide administrative support to the department, including publications, mailings, calendars, phone calls, etc.
- 5. Work amicably in conjunction with other Student Ministries staff and the greater church staff by performing other duties as assigned.

Knowledge and Experience

- 1. Growing personal commitment to Jesus Christ, the body of Christ and God's work in the world.
- 2. Ability to work effectively with youth, exhibiting creativity, understanding and patience.
- 3. Excellent communication skills (verbal and written).
- 4. Flexibility in a multi-task, fast-paced, changing environment.

Internship Details

- 1. Benefits to intern:
 - a. Gain practical ministry training and church experience
 - b. Work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support
 - c. Test their gifts and call to vocational ministry
 - d. Develop spiritually and theologically
- 2. Education: this internship is designed for post-college applicants who have a strong interest or passion in ministry.
- 3. Duration of internship: One year (starting date between June 1, 2014 and August 31, 2014) with possible extension for an additional year.
- 4. Compensation: This is a full-time paid position with a salary of \$19,385 per year.
- 5. Housing: Room and board with a host family from Chapel Hill may be provided if requested.
- 6. Benefits: health (medical, dental, vision, life insurance, disability), vacation (2 weeks per year), sick leave, holiday pay. Health coverage begins the first of the month following 30 days of employment. Other benefits accrue from date of hire.
